

Fodder Development:

In general Livestock development is one of the main alternative source of income for the people living in our State. It brings additional income through selling of milk, milk products, meat, etc. As the livestock population is growing in these watershed villages, there is a need to fill the demand – supply gap of fodder which can also be a healthy food to the livestock. To cater this growing need of fodder, we have distributed Co4 variety of fodder stems to these watershed villages.

During the period 2020 - 2021, 20 beneficiaries in K.N.Palayam watershed, 5 beneficiaries in Narumanam, 11 beneficiaries in Pulleri watershed were provided with 1500 Co4 variety fodder stems each.

These fodder stems had grown well in the field of 10 cents. The farmers had started to feed the fodder crop to dairy cattle. This variety of fodder crop will help to improve the fat content of milk, thus increasing the income of these marginal farmers. From the matured fodder stems, farmers will be able to produce more fodder throughout the year, thus providing a sustainable
